Installation Instructions

You will need to download and install the following elements for FriendlyRoboCopy to work properly. Before you start, create a folder in your favorite directory where you will store all of the pieces. Let Perl and its module install in their default locations, but make sure the rest of the files you download are in that folder that you created.

What you need to run FriendlyRoboCopy properly:

- Perl

- version 5.8.3 or better. Download from:

<http://www.activestate.com/Products/ActivePerl/?mp=1>.

- Perl Modules

- Win32::DirSize module

- Math::Round module


In case you cannot find Win32::DirSize module, do the following:

- Go to CPAN: <http://search.cpan.org/~arich/Win32-DirSize-1.13/Win32/DirSize/DirSize.pm>

- Download the .tar.gz file (top right of the screen)

- Decompress, unzip (if you use winZip, it does everything at once)

- Place the different files in the folders indicated below. Be aware that the four last files are already included in the DirSize directory.

-Download from:

-FriendlyRoboCopy

-The link from the web site will download automatically. Once the *entire* file is downloaded, select ALL the text, copy it, open a notepad and paste the text in it.

Save the file in the folder you created and call it robo.pl (the icon will turn into a salamander).

-The link called FriendlyRoboCopy User's Guide will download FriendlyRoboCopy User's Guide. Save the file in your folder and call it Guide.pdf (respect the capital).

-The link called RoboCopy Documentation will download official RoboCopy documentation. Save the file in your folder and call it RoboCopy.pdf (respect the capitals).

Running Instructions

After following the instructions above, it is time to try FriendlyRoboCopy.

-Launch a Command Window.

-Navigate to the folder you created—where the .pl file is saved

-Type perl robo.pl and press enter.
